Common Questions and Concerns

- **I don't want to invest a lot because I'm not sure if my child will stick with it.**
 - Perfectly understandable. It is important for the parent to provide the best possible instrument they can afford. The formula for success is a great teacher, adequate piano and full parental support. Bet on your child's success not their failure.
- **Can my child start on a small keyboard?**
 - Keyboards are not pianos. High quality "Digital Pianos" are a better choice. Good digital pianos have 88 full size keys that are weighted and touch sensitive in a cabinet with pedals. This ideally is a secondary option to a real piano.
- **Grandma has a piano we can have, or I found a free one on craigslist.com, or there is one for sale in the paper.**
 - Pianos have 12,000 plus parts, over 230 strings, is 80% wood, and needs to be tuned every year. If you are not a piano technician it is difficult to know weather the piano is in good shape or not. Beware.
- **What do I need to get started?**
 - We have three easy affordable options to help get you started

Option 1: Rent a Digital Piano
